

Department of Sociology Study Abroad Scholarships

The University at Buffalo Department of Sociology offers several scholarships for students who will study abroad. Awards to scholarship recipients will be paid into student UB accounts to be used exclusively towards paying program fees either for *UB Semester in London* or for the *UB London Winter Session: Sociology of Food* program. Other programs will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Applications are due by Sept. 29.

Several scholarships are available:

- At least two \$1500 scholarships (for sociology majors only) and two \$500 scholarships (non-majors are eligible) for students admitted to the *UB Semester in London* program.
- At least two \$400 scholarships (for sociology majors only) and two \$250 scholarships (non-majors are eligible) for students admitted to the *UB London Winter Session: Sociology of Food*.

Recipients of the *Department of Sociology Study Abroad Scholarships* must fulfill a service requirement that involves assisting UB Study Abroad Programs or the Department to encourage and educate other UB students about study abroad opportunities. For this reason, applicants who are returning to UB for at least one semester will be given preference for this scholarship, although all completed applications are considered. Recipients must also provide the Department of Sociology with a brief written summary of their experience abroad within one month of the official program end date. That summary may appear on the Department website.

All applications are due September 29. Late applications cannot be reviewed.

Requirements:

- Applicants must be currently enrolled, full-time UB undergraduate students in good academic standing.
- Applicants must have completed all components of the online applications to the *UB Semester in London* or *UB London Winter Session: Sociology of Food* programs, or other program as appropriate.
- Priority will be given to first-time study abroad participants.
- Recipients must fulfill a service requirement upon return, to promote study abroad at UB.

Applications consist of:

- Application Form (required)
- Copy of current Academic Advisement Report or official transcript (required)
- Copy of official financial aid statement (if applicable)
- Financial Statement (required)
- Study Abroad Statement (required)
- Service Requirement Statement (required)
- Copy of current Financial Aid award (if applicable)

Finalists may be called for personal interviews. The Sociology Study Abroad Scholarship Committee will review only complete application packages and make all award decisions. All decisions will be final and will not be subject to appeal.

Submit the completed application form (next page) and other required application materials via a single document in an email attachment to Professor Kristen Schultz Lee (467 Park Hall; kslee4@buffalo.edu) by the relevant deadline. Please put "Scholarship" in the email subject line when you make your submission.

Awards will be announced within one week of the application deadline, based on criteria that include financial need and academic merit. Only complete packages, with all documents submitted at one time, and for students who have also completed the relevant study abroad application, will be reviewed. Please assemble all of the materials you need for consideration for the scholarship before you send your email, since only complete packages with all materials included in a single email message will be reviewed.
